to be granted to socially-mobile students.

If you:

- Attended a state school and are the first generation of your family to attend University;
- AND/OR received a scholarship or bursary because of your family income/social mobility status;
- AND/OR consider yourself to be from a low-income background;
- AND/OR received free school meals aged 11-16 due to financial hardship;
- AND/OR spent time in local authority care;
- Who has been a refugee/asylum seeker;
- In paid employment during your A-levels for 20+ hours per week;
- In paid employment during your undergraduate degree for 10+ hours per week.

You will be eligible to apply!

Applicants MUST:

- Be in the United Kingdom, planning a career as a solicitor in England or Wales;
- Be over 18 years old on the day of their application
- Be able to demonstrate a commitment to pursuing a career as a solicitor
- Be currently on, or have a place confirmed at, a part time or full time undergraduate or postgraduate course.



Tips for a successful application

- Ensure you have a professional or academic referee who has agreed to provide a reference.
- Provide detailed evidence about your commitment to a career in law.
- Be realistic about your request. Research and provide details on the options and cost of what you are applying for. Trustees typically grant high-quality Windows laptops.
- Take time to read and complete the application form properly. All of the details and instructions are on our website.
